If any parents have children in both groups, please do attend First Communion session.

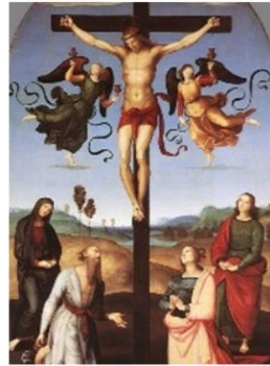
Dates: Sessions will take place on Saturday:
